



Policies for Casselodge Barn Loft Guests

Casselodge is our private residence, and we ask that guests respectfully treat it as such. Casselodge is available exclusively to guests who have reserved and is not open to the public. We ask that guests not invite outsiders to Casselodge who do not have a reservation.

PLEASE NOTE: We reserve the right to terminate a reservation for guests who do not abide by our policies.

| Barn Loft | The Barn Loft is an apartment-style accommodation, which is fully furnished, however does not include "breakfast". Guests are welcome to bring their own food supplies. The Barn Loft is available exclusively to registered guests and not open to the public. Guests who are afraid of animals or who are allergic to animals and hay should refrain from reserving the Barn Loft. |
| BBQ & eat-in facilities | A charcoal BBQ is located at the outdoor campfire. The apartment has full kitchen facilities. Guests can utilize any of the outdoor areas to have their picnic and are asked to clean up and leave things as they found them. |
| Camp Fire | Campfires are allowed as long as the fire does not exceed the by-law requirement, which is 3 feet in height. A wood pile is provided at the camp fire, along with matches and blankets which are in the storage bin next to the campfire. |
| Check-in / Check-out times | Check-in is anytime between 4-8 pm (16:00 to 20:00) by appointment only. Please confirm your time of arrival at least 24 hrs in advance so that we are there to greet you. Check-out is anytime prior to 11:00 am. Additional fees will apply if you would like to check-in earlier or check-out later. |
| Children | Children must be supervised at all times, especially around animals, close to the river and pond areas, near farm equipment, near a campfire or any other area you feel may be a danger to your child. |
| Damages/Repairs | If you find something missing, damaged or not working, or if you lose, break, stain or spill something, please let us know. For severe damages or loss of items, a fee may apply. |

| Fire extinguishers | A fire extinguisher is located in the kitchen. |
| Footwear inside/outside the house | To maintain cleanliness, we ask that outdoor footwear not be worn inside the Barn Loft. An assortment of clean slippers/flip flops is provided for your convenience. Please feel free to wear your own clean indoor footwear. Or, you can walk bare-feet or bare-socks in the barn loft. Although it's practical to walk outside, we ask that you wear your outdoor footwear and refrain from wearing indoor sandals/flip-flops or walk with your socks/bare feet while outside. |
| Ironing board / iron | Located in the closet next to the entrance. |

| Keys | The Barn Loft is equipped with a door that locks and a key is provided to ensure security. If you leave, please be sure to bring your key with you. A \$20 fee will apply to keys that are lost, stolen or damaged. |
| Payment & Cancellation | <p>We accept cash, credit card, e-transfer and personal cheques.</p> <p>To guarantee your reservation, we require a \$25.00 deposit and credit card number. The deposit is non-refundable unless you reschedule. A one-night stay will apply for cancellations made within 24hrs.</p> <p>For guests who can only stay one night from May 1 to October 1, a deposit of \$75.00 will apply (to include \$50 cleaning fee).</p> <p>For severe damages, a fee will apply.</p> |
| Relaxation and other activities | <p>We pride ourselves on creating a relaxing environment for our guests. The following services/activities are available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glider swing • Various chairs, bistro tables, gazebos • Take a walk on the path in our forest • Canoe, 2 kayaks and life preservers, bicycles, snow shoes are all available upon request • Indoor and outdoor games • We are in close proximity to Larose Forest where you can enjoy long walks, snow shoeing, cross country skiing |
| Respect for the environment | The Barn Loft is equipped with wastebaskets and recycling bins and compost bin. We are on well water and septic and ask our guests to minimize water waste. Please refrain from throwing anything except toilet paper in the toilet. All other items should be discarded in the wastebasket. |
| Respect for people | We are respectful of all people and we value diversity and as such, are respectful and courteous of all of our guests. We do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, age, national or ethnic origin, religion, sexual orientation, and marital or family status. We expect that our guests demonstrate tolerance as well as courteous and polite behavior. A zero tolerance policy applies in the event a guest demonstrates aggressive, disrespectful and abusive behavior and they will be asked to leave. |
| Smoking/Smoke Alarms/Carbon Monoxide Detectors | Smoking is not permitted inside the Barn Loft, but you can certainly smoke outside, provided an ashtray is used to dispose of the cigarette butts. The barn shelters hay, and we ask our guests to smoke at least 20 feet from the buildings in order to avoid a fire. For your safety, the Barn Loft is equipped with 2 smoke detectors and one carbon monoxide detector. |
